01/2009: Adoption of agenda

Decision:

The agenda was adopted, with the following amendments:

02/2009: Adoption of Minutes from Meeting on Monday, 6 October 2008

The Minutes was circulated electronically after the Meeting 6 October 2008 and approved.

Decision:

The Minutes were adopted.

03/2009: Conflicts of interest

The conflicts of interest were only deemed relevant for the case of BILAT, 04/2009. It was therefore decided that it should be discussed during the introduction of the BILAT-case. Because of the late arrival of the board member Fledelius, 04/2009 was postponed to be addressed after dealing with other items related to the Cooperation Programme with Russia. This way, the Board ensured a minimum number of members to be present, making proceedings of the meeting valid. Upon the arrival of member Karsten Fledelius, it was agreed that Jasna Bogunovic Jakobsen and Elisabeth Roman should not participate during the discussion of the procedures for the handling of the BILAT applications. The Board considered that Jakobsen and Roman were in conflict of interests.

***Decision:** The board members Jasna Bogunovic Jakobsen and Elisabeth Roman due to their conflicts of interest should not participate in the allocation of the BILAT- funds. The remaining points on the agenda, however, should first proceed with Jakobsen and Roman present, leaving the handling of BILAT-fund as the final point of the meeting.*

Cooperation Programme with Russia**05/2009 Visit (monitoring) of projects in Russia.**

Following the Programme Board's decision to monitor education and research projects in Russia by a visit in 2009 (decision from 27/08) the Secretariat suggested one trip to St. Petersburg with a possible extension to Arkhangelsk. The Board commented this to be too long and ambitious and recommended that the Secretariat should plan for two shorter and separate trips.

Decision:

The Programme Board authorizes the Secretariat to plan for institutional visits during week 20 of 2009 within the financial limits of NOK 150 000. A sum not exceeding NOK 50 000 can be allocated to visits and meetings with projects in Norway. The Secretariat will prepare a template for the institutional visits.

09/2009 Annual reports, education projects SIU

The Secretariat presents the reports to the Board. The Programme Board has to approve the transfer of unspent funds. SIU presented in total 7 reports.

04/2009: BILAT

The Cooperation Programme with Russia had one announcement of BILAT-funds (2009-2010) with application deadline 11 February 2009. The funds are distributed from the Ministry of Education and Research to the Research Council and comprise NOK 4.8 million for the period 2009-2010. 27 applications were received, whereas one rejected.
