

## Eurasia Programme, Project funding 2011

By application deadline 6 June 2011, the Eurasia Programme had received 13 eligible applications for project funding, at a total amount of NOK 54 210 984.

The applications were handled by the Eurasia Programme Board in its meeting 13th September 2011.
