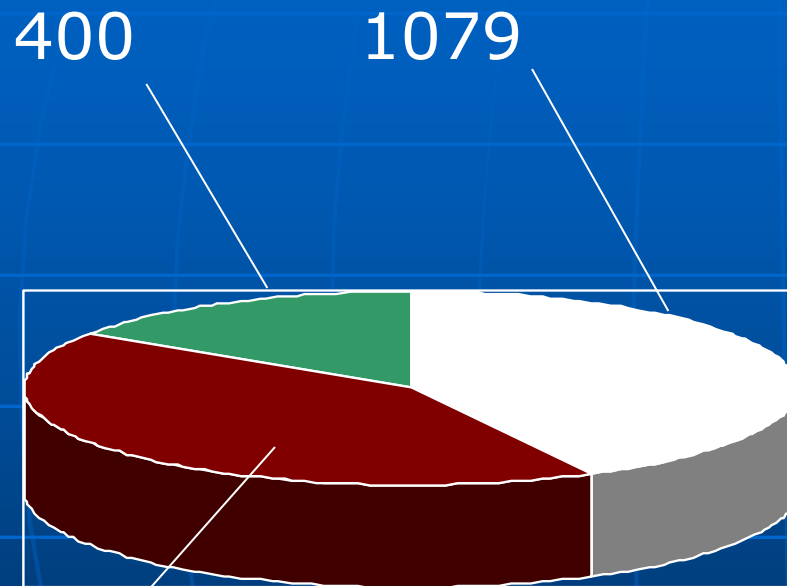

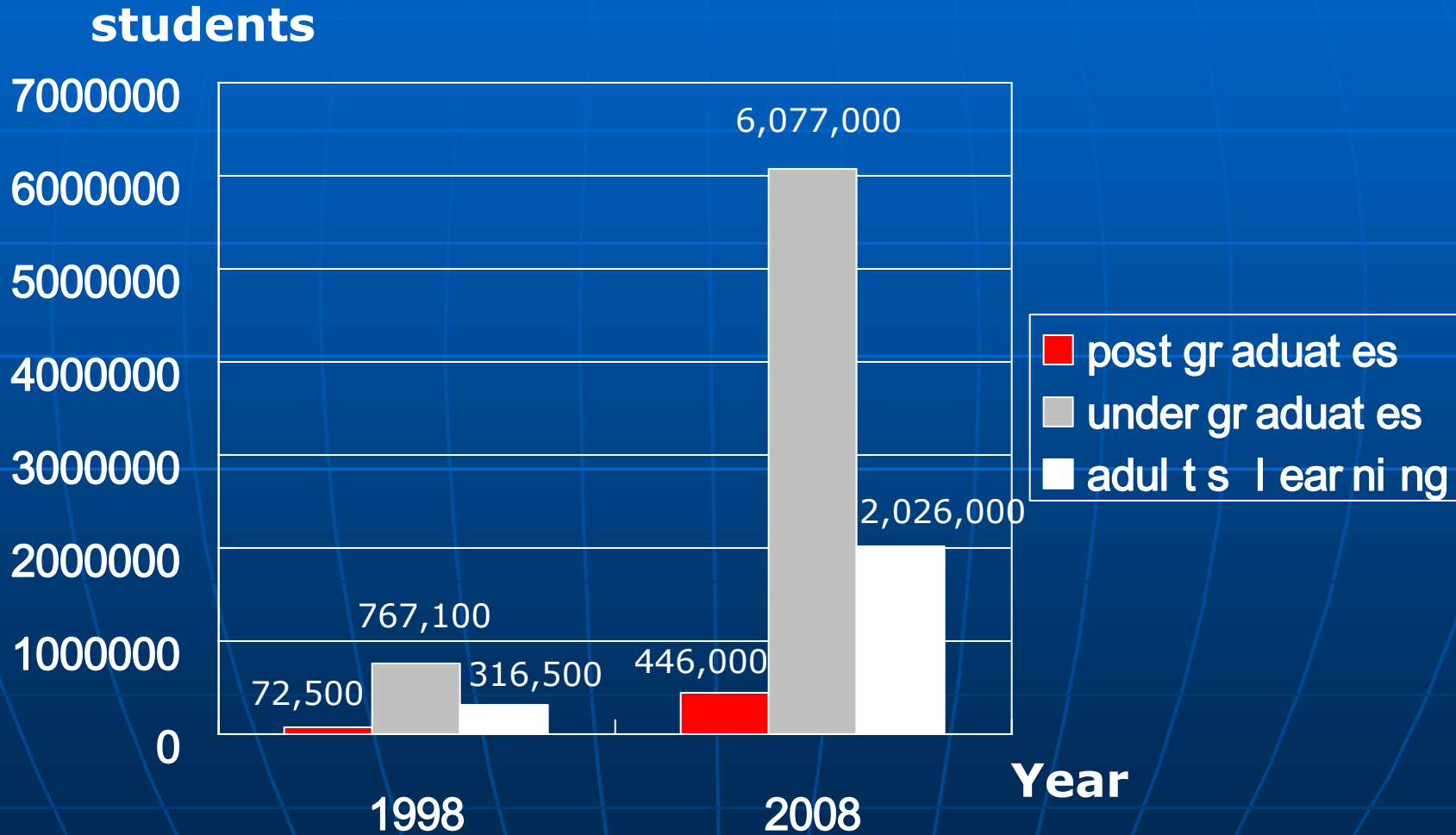

### Number of new recruitment students



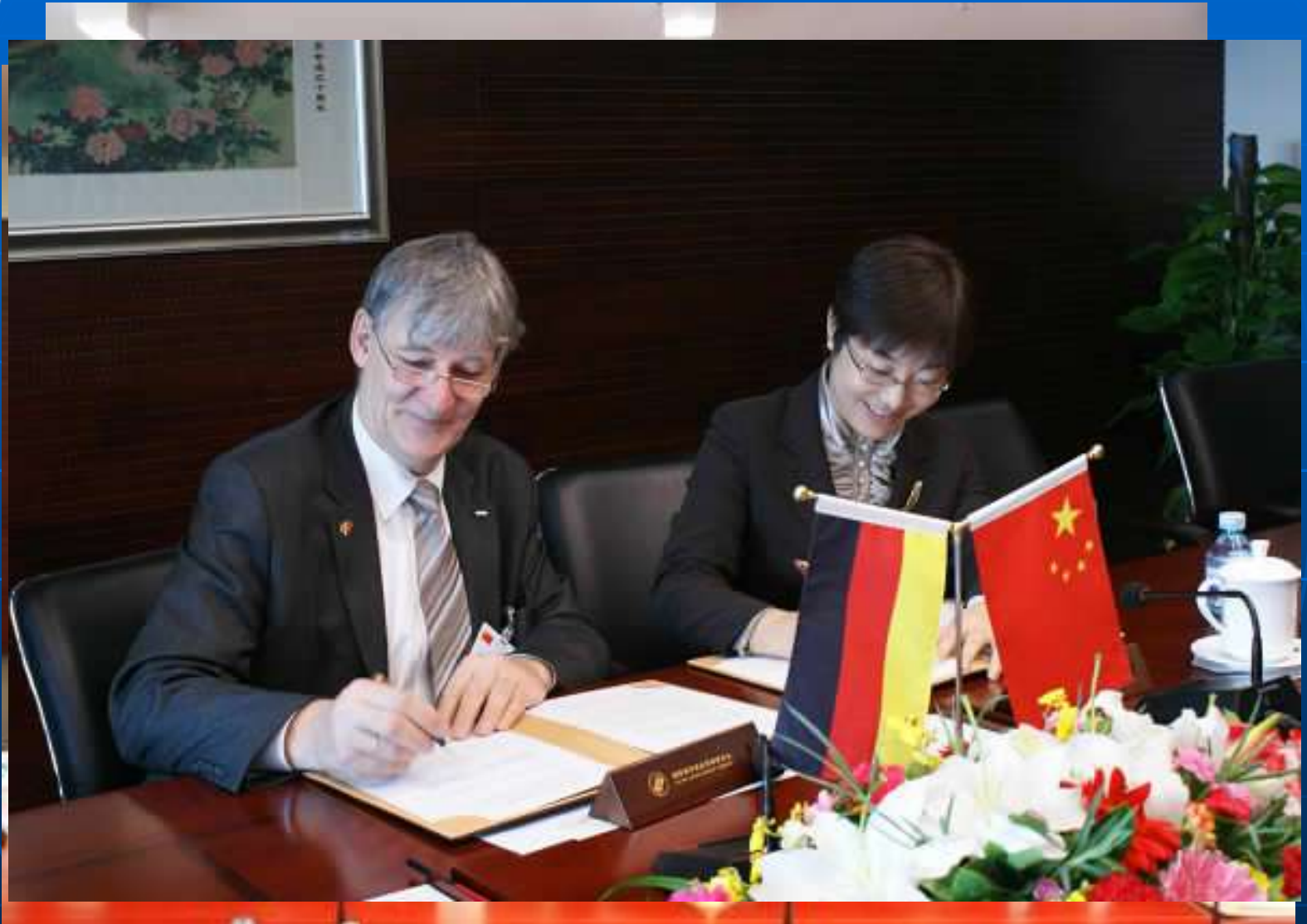


## Part II . Internationalization

- ◆ Cooperation with 189 countries ; 18 high level education dialogue mechanisms
- ◆ Over 154 agreements educational exchanges have been signed
- ◆ Signed agreements of mutual recognition of academic credentials and degrees with 34 countries like Germany, France, the UK and Australia etc.

## Part II . Internationalization

- ◆ established the education cooperative and exchange relations with more than 40 important International organizations such as the UNESCO, the World Bank etc.
- ◆ 179,800 were sent were sent in 2008,a total of 1,391,500 studying abroad during 1978-2008
- ◆ 240,000 students studying in China in 2009, comparing only 1,200 in 1978.Total received 1,230,000 person-times international students from more than 180 countries since 1979.

CSC special scholarship programs for study abroad

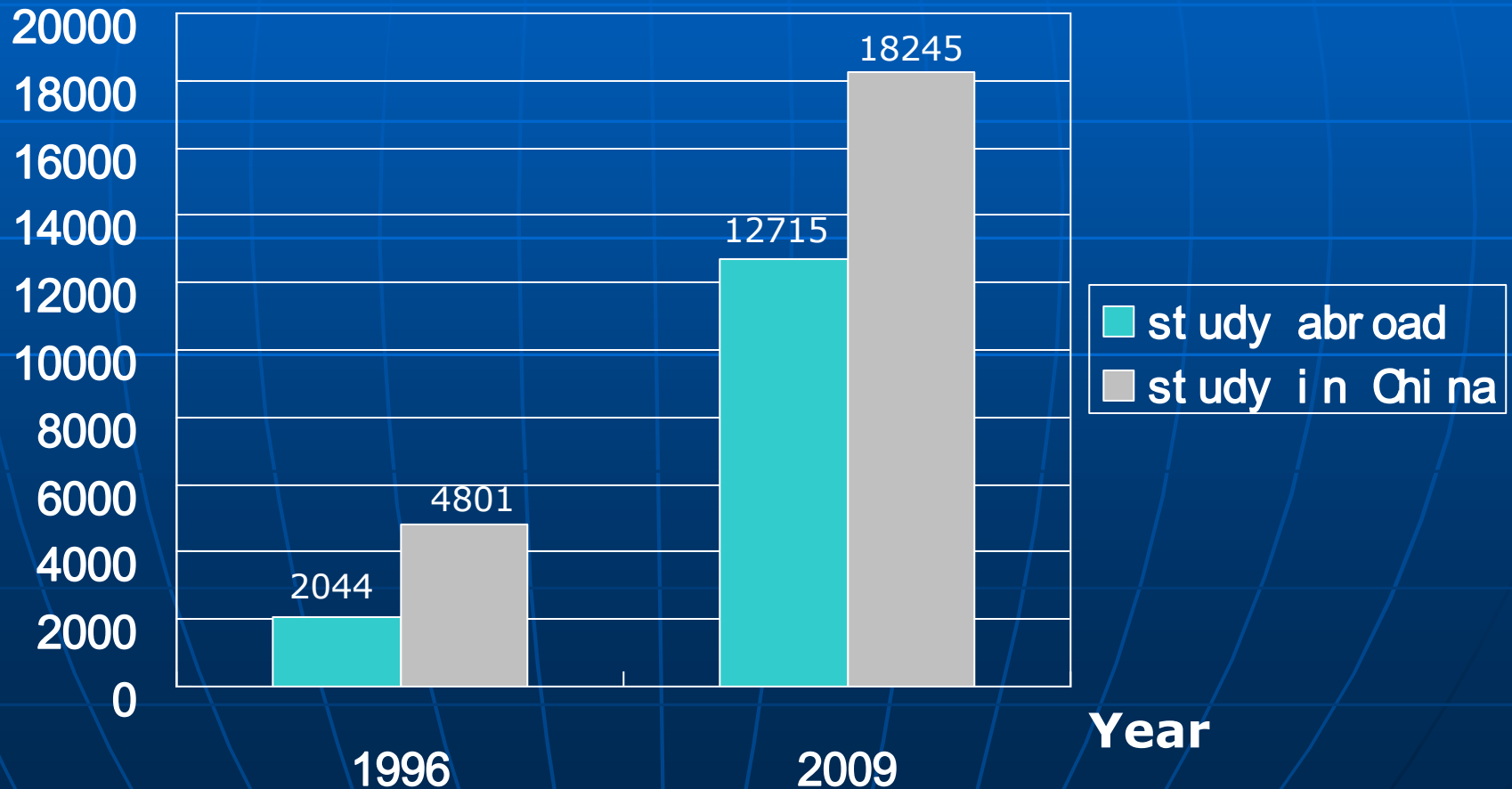
- Talents Training Program for Western China (2003): a total of 2,856 people recruited from the western 12 provinces and regions.
